

# Ces i fy ngeni I was born



The word **fy** causes a **nasal mutation** here so **geni** turns to **ngeni**

**Ces i fy ngeni yn Aberystwyth**  
**Mi ges i fy ngeni yn Abersoch**

*I was born in Aberystwyth*  
*I was born in Abersoch*

In some part of Wales you might hear the word **mi** at the beginning of sentences. It doesn't mean anything by itself, but does cause a **soft mutation** here!

**Ces i fy ngeni yng Ngheredigion**  
**Mi ges i fy ngeni ym Mangor**

*I was born in Ceredigion*  
*I was born in Bangor*

The word **yn** causes a **nasal mutation** too, so place names, and the word **yn** itself, can change as well!
