You may find variations of these verbs – particularly cael. You’ll sometimes see ‘mi’ at the beginning too. This doesn’t mean anything by itself but is a form often seen yn y Gogledd. For example ‘mi es i’ – ‘I went’. Using ‘mi’ requires a mutation, ‘mi **dd**es i’ – ‘I came’.

There are other forms for the negative and the question too. For example ‘ddest ti?’ ‘did you come?’ and ‘wnes i ddim’ – ‘I didn’t make’
